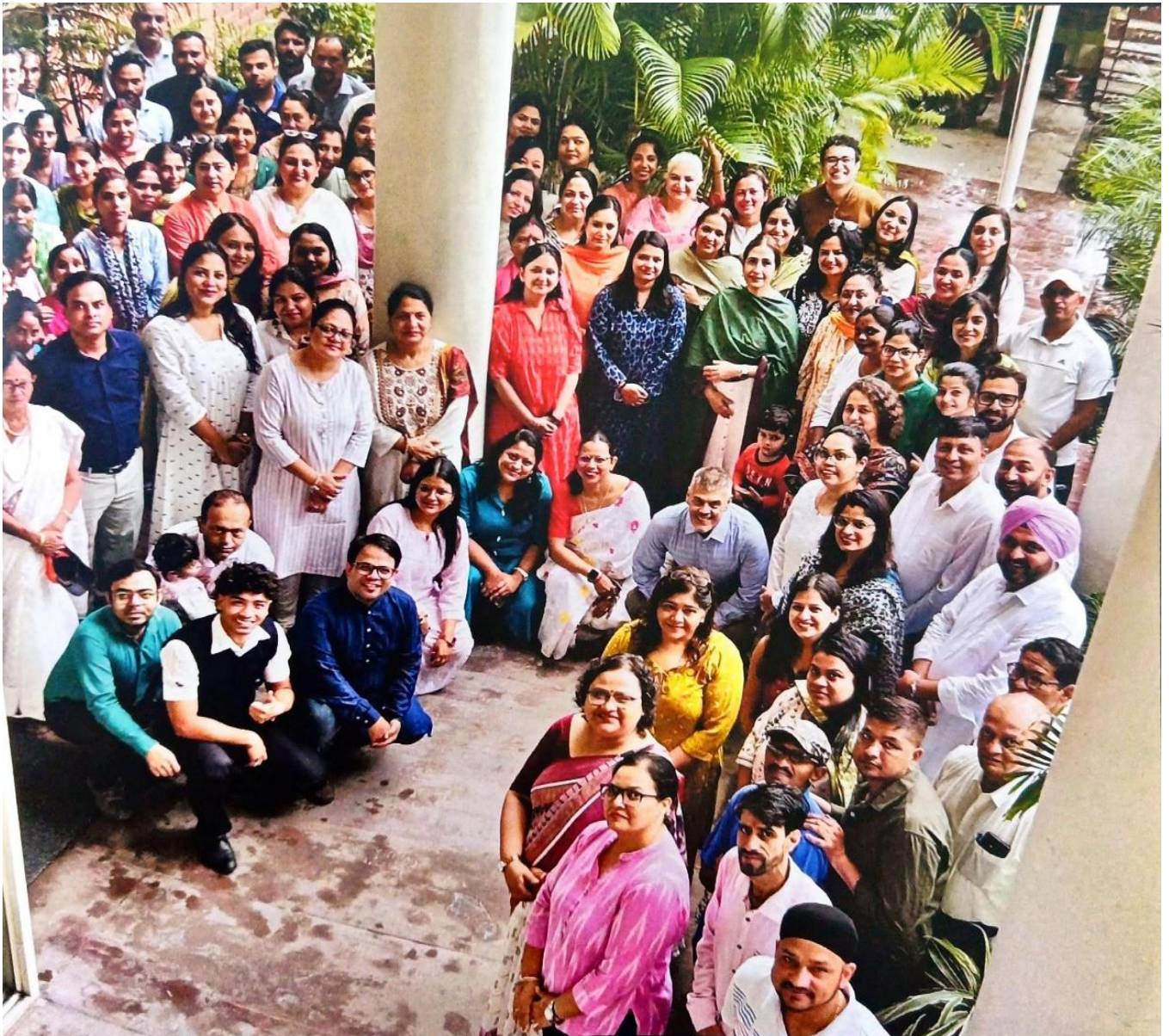
After the discussion of the policy, display of the digital messages created by the students using the 'popplet app' was done. With that the students took a pledge to save the environment by following the 3R's policy.

1. INDEPENDENCE DAY

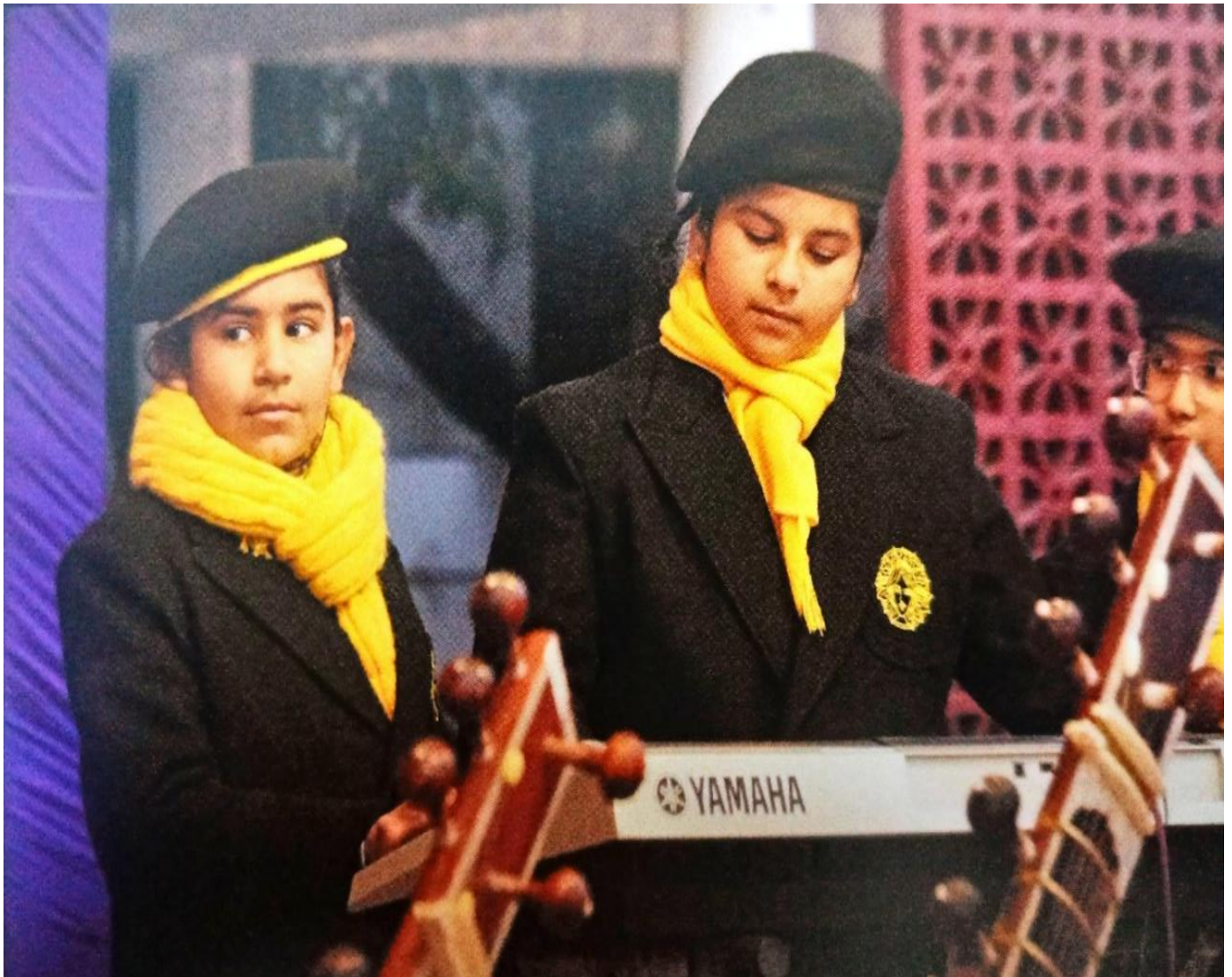

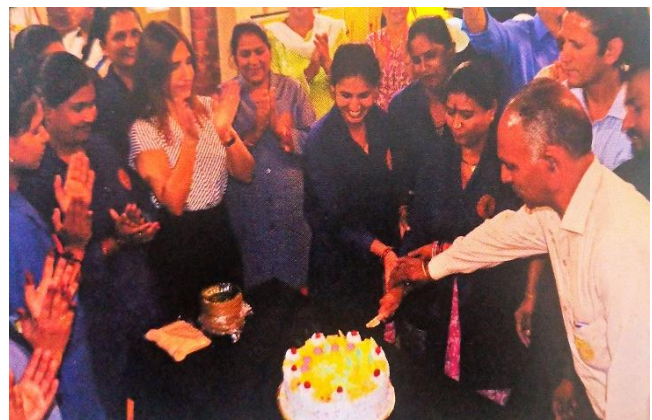
4. MOTHER'S DAY

9. POSTER MAKING

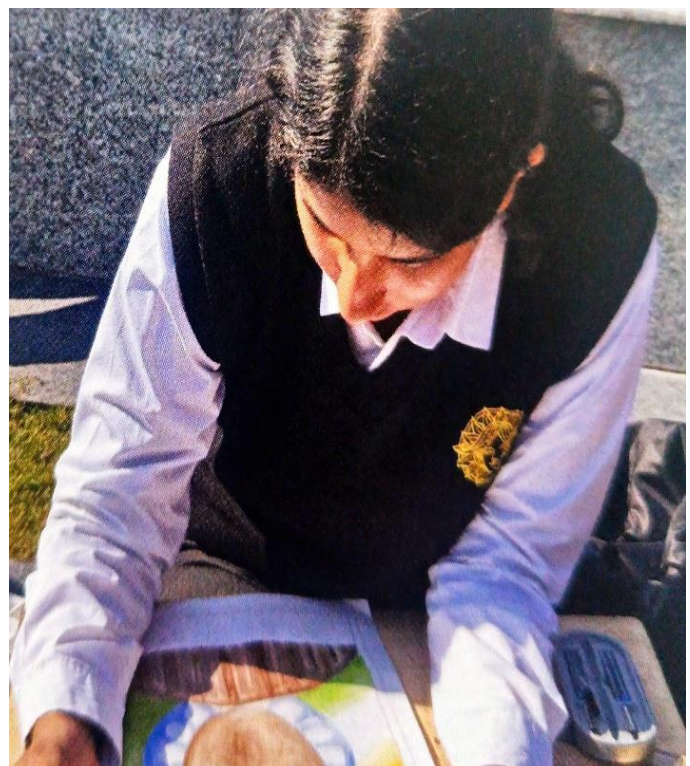

13. REPUBLIC DAY

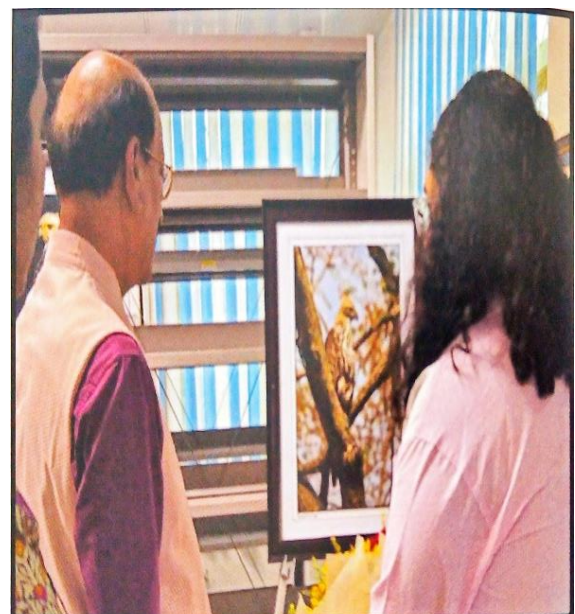
